Bishop Leibold Athletic Association Annual Scholar/Athlete Award Known as Pope John Paul II Character Award

MISSION: As a community of Catholics, for over a quarter of a century, one of the missions of the Bishop Leibold Athletic Association is to facilitate the Pope John Paul II Character Award. We continue to financially assist Bishop Leibold School, Our Lady of Good Hope CCD, and St. Henry PSR student-athletes, of high character, in continuing their education at a Catholic high school. The award must be used at a Catholic high school.

HISTORY: Since this scholarship's inception over 26 years ago, more than 630 student-athletes have applied for this scholarship. Awards of over \$54,000 have been granted to more than 79 student-athletes. This award continues to help students continue their Catholic education in a Dayton Area Catholic high school.

FUNDING: The award became independently funded through the Bishop Leibold Athletic Association in 2007. The independent funding does not affect other Bishop Leibold School Awards that are awarded. This results in the Pope John Paul II Character Award being an unassociated award from the school.

TIMETABLE: Applications, forms, and instructions will be available on or around **April 10, 2018, and are due back no later than Friday, April 27, 2018.** Interviews and evaluations are performed over the following weeks in May and recipients are announced at the annual Bishop Leibold Athletic Association Awards ceremony in May.

CRITERIA: 8th-grade student-athletes will be evaluated on the following criteria: personal interview; academics; character essay; BLAA sports participation; other activities; teacher recommendations; and coach recommendations.

ELIGIBILITY: THIS AWARD IS FOR 8TH GRADE STUDENTS ONLY. STUDENTS MUST HAVE PARTICIPATED IN AN 8TH GRADE BLAA SPORTS PROGRAM AS A BLS, OUR LADY OF GOOD HOPE CCD, OR ST. HENRY PSR STUDENT ATHLETE.

FINANCIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD DISTRIBUTION: The total financial award will equal \$2,000 with one boy earning a \$1,000 award and one girl earning a \$1,000 award that must be used toward their freshman year of education at a Dayton Area Catholic high school. If the winner does not go to a Dayton Area Catholic high school, then the runner-up will be granted the monetary sum and be granted the Pope John Paul II Character Award winner for that year.

Dear Student Applicant,

We are pleased to provide this letter of introduction, for all eighth-grade students and their parents, to the Bishop Leibold Athletic Association's POPE JOHN PAUL II CHARACTER AWARD selection process. This letter will explain what the student applicant must do to be considered for the award. This is not an athletic scholarship. It is awarded by the Athletic Association and not necessarily to the best athlete. Adults who do not know the students or their families will assess the student applicant. They will be judged solely on the merits of their application information (including application, essay, and evaluations) and their interviews.

The award will provide financial assistance to each of two students, one male and one female, who have participated in the Bishop Leibold Athletic sports programs sometime during their eighth-grade year. Any current eighth-grade student at Bishop Leibold School or the PSR/CCD programs at St. Henry or Our Lady of Good Hope church is eligible. This financial assistance, in the amount of \$1,000, will be applied towards the tuition costs for the freshman year at a Dayton Area Catholic high school.

POPE JOHN PAUL II CHARACTER AWARD application packets will be available by Monday, April 9, 2018, on the Bishop Leibold School website www.bishopleibold.org (under the "Current Parents" link). Packets include a letter to the student applicant, a letter to the parents, the award application form, the coach's evaluation form, and the teacher's evaluation forms.

The student applicant must distribute the teacher and coach evaluation forms to the teacher and BLS coach of their choice. The teacher and coach must complete the form and return the completed form in a sealed envelope, clearly identifying the contents, to the BLS East Campus Office NO LATER THAN Friday, May 4, 2018–NO EXCEPTIONS. The student is not to see these evaluations. The teacher will supply validated grade averages. It is the student's responsibility to check and make sure that everything has been submitted before the noted deadline. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE PERMITTED!

The applicants will be required to appear before the Award Selection Committee for a personal interview on approximately Wednesday, May 23, 2018, (tentative date) at the BLS East Campus. Questions asked in the personal interview will further define a particular topic from the essay or application. Common questions are asked of all candidates to provide a single point of reference to judge their reasoning, poise, and quick thinking. The finalists will be notified of their interview times.

STUDENT APPLICANTS WILL BE JUDGED SOLELY ON THE APPLICATION, ESSAY, EVALUATIONS, AND INTERVIEW. SPELLING ERRORS, EVENT SEQUENCING, AND GRAMMAR, AS WELL AS, APPLICATION COMPLETENESS AND NEATNESS ARE VERY IMPORTANT.
